Greetings St. Paul Lutheran Church!

Can you believe it's September already? Hopefully you are ready for it. Each Sunday in September there is something unique during or after worship. Here's a synopsis of the month.

Sunday, September 1 – St. Paul's new Director of Music Ministries Fonda Davies starts. (See page 9 for information from her). During worship we will have a liturgy of welcome and blessing as she starts her ministry with us. And after worship, during coffee hour, we will have a celebration of the beginning of her ministry.

Sunday, September 8 – "God's Work Our Hands" Sunday! This is the day we wear the Yellow T- shirts. There is a new shipment on the way, so if you haven't received one, please let me know. A donation of \$16 is appreciated (but not required) for a shirt.

Dr. Barbara Rossing "will lead us through the book of Revelation as we discover its theme of hope, not fear, and a renewed world in which all are welcome and have enough. We will be on a journey to the beautiful city and river of life". I have loved Rev. Dr. Rossing's book Raptured Exposed: The Message of Hope in the Book of Revelation since my seminary days. I look forward to this time to worship, gather with colleagues, and continue learning from Rev. Dr. Rossing. I love the idea of hope, not fear. I always liken it to the Monster's Inc movies. Sunday, September 22 - I will be back to preside at worship, but since I will have been gone all week, John Beyer will be preaching. While I love preaching and feel like it is one of my gifts, it is always good to get different perspectives and voices (once in awhile).

Sunday, September 29 – This is the time of year we start St. Paul's Justice Ministry with Sarasota United for Responsibility and Equity (SURE). The year begins with a House Meeting or a Sacred Conversation. It is a time to hear about what our Justice Ministry Team does and renew our commitment to it. I invite you stay and hear about the ministry, my passion for it, and how we can work for the common of good of Sarasota in the coming year.




